Resolution 1 (II). Headquarters Agreement

The International Tropical Timber Council, ...

Availing itself of the opportunity of its second session to formally record its acceptance of the "Revised offer of Japan to invite the headquarters of the International Tropical Timber Organization" dated 26 June, 1985,

Taking note of the facilities already placed at the disposal of the International Tropical Timber Organization by the authorities of the host country,

Taking account of the report of the Chairperson of the Headquarters

Committee,

Convinced that the conclusion of a Headquarters Agreement is a prerequisite for the establishment of the secretariat of the International Tropical Timber Organization and the effective discharge of its functions in fulfilment of the purposes of the organization,

<u>Urges</u> the Government of Japan and the Headquarters Committee to make every effort to finalize a draft agreement as soon as possible,

Invites the Headquarters Committee to submit the draft agreement to the Council at its next session,

Earnestly hopes that during the period prior to the conclusion of such an Agreement, the Government of Japan will continue to make every effort to facilitate the smooth functioning of the International Tropical Timber Organization and the effective establishment of its secretariat.
