### INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON PROMOTION OF INTRA-AFRICAN TRADE IN TIMBER AND TIMBER PRODUCTS

### La Palm Royal Beach Hotel, Accra, Ghana 30 June – 2 July 2009

The International Tropical Timber Organization (ITTO) in collaboration with the Ministry of Forestry, Lands and Natural Resources of Ghana are convening an international conference on Promotion of Intra-African Trade in Timber and Timber Products from 30 June to 2 July 2009 at the La Palm Royal Beach Hotel in Accra, Ghana.

### Objectives

- (1) An overview of the current level of the intra-African market for tropical timber and timber products (TTP) particularly in relation to products traded, their quality, price, and end uses;
- (2) An overview and analysis of the nature and trends of supply and availability of tropical timber and timber products in ITTO member countries in Africa in terms of quality, quantity, price and potential end uses;
- (3) Overview and analysis of the nature and trends of demand for tropical timber and timber products in ITTO member countries in Africa and other major markets in Africa, in particular in countries neighboring ITTO producing member countries in Africa and the Northern and Southern parts of Africa;
- (4) Identification and analysis of constraints to the expansion of the intra-African market for tropical timber and timber products, as well as options to overcome the constraints and key players who could help remove those constraints;
- (5) Concrete proposals to promote the intra-African market for TTPs, including the formulation of practical measures that could be implemented in the short, medium and long term period; and
- (6) Identification and analysis of regional initiatives that could be considered in order to build cooperation and synergies with a view to promoting the intra-Africa market for timber and timber products.

### Who will attend

This conference will bring together a wide range of stakeholders, including senior executives from major forest products companies, private and public sector financial institutions, forest product market development agencies, customs authorities, chamber of commerce and leading forestry and conservation agencies from around the world to facilitate information exchange and identify mechanisms for the promotion of intra-African trade in timber and timber products.

### Venue

The conference will be convened at the La Palm Royal Beach Hotel in Accra, Ghana. It is located only 10 minutes away from Ghana's main airport, the Kotoka International Airport in Accra, and 15 minutes away from the Accra city centre.



### How to Get to Ghana

All major international airlines from Europe, except Air France, have daily flights to Accra. Below are flights within Africa:

#### **Immigration and Entry Requirements**

Generally, temporary visitors to Ghana are required to obtain an entry visa. Detailed information on visa requirements can be found at the nearest Embassy or Consulate of Ghana. In general, participants must hold passports which are valid for at least six months after the date of arrival. However, in the event that there is no Ghanaian diplomatic representation in the country of origin, the Government of Ghana will assist with the issuance of visas on arrival at the Kotoka International Airport in Accra or any border point of entry into Ghana. To facilitate these procedures, participants who wish to receive an entry visa to Ghana upon arrival should complete all the details in the attached form (see Annex I) and return it to the address shown below by fax or e-mail as soon as possible. The information should reach Ramel two weeks before arrival date.

Please note that this form should be completed with full detailed information and any missing information on the form may seriously delay the processing. This form should reach the above address as soon as possible and not later than 15 June 2009. Please note that for visa issued upon arrival, the visa fee is USD 100.00.

ITTO Secretariat cannot assist in facilitating entry visas to be issued upon arrival.

### Exemptions

ECOWAS nationals and those of the Countries with which the Government of Ghana has specific bilateral agreements, are exempted. The following are so far considered exempted Countries.

Under Section 3 (Exemption) of the Ghana Visa Regulations, the following Countries and Categories of persons are exempted from entry visas to Ghana.

- a) Citizens of ECOWAS Countries with valid documents or the necessary visas.
- b) Nationals of the following Countries:
  - \* Kenya
  - \* Zimbabwe
  - \* Egypt
  - \* Singapore
  - \* Hong Kong specialized Administrative Areas
  - \* Mauritius
- c) Holders of Cuban Diplomatic Passport
- d) Holders of German Diplomatic and Service Passport for a period not exceeding three (3) months.
- e) Holders of Passports of Regional Economic Communities of Africa and African Economic Community

Nationals of the following Commonwealth East and Southern Africa Countries may obtain Ghana Entry Visas from Missions / Consulates abroad or may obtain visas at the point of Entry in Ghana.

The Commonwealth East and South African Countries include:

- \* Malawi
- \* Swaziland
- \* Tanzania
- \* Zambia
- \* Lesotho
- \* Uganda
- \* Botswana.

#### Inoculation

In accordance with International Health Regulations all persons entering Ghana are requested to have valid certificates of Immunization against Yellow Fever.

Valid Certificate of inoculation against Yellow Fever will be inspected at point of entry into Ghana (at Kotoka International Airport and any other air or seaports).
