REPORT OF THE ITTO FELLOWSHIP SELECTION PANEL

(Item 19 of the Provisional Agenda)

1. Fellowship selection for 2011 was conducted electronically. However, the Panel met once during the Forty-seventh Session of the ITTC to finalize the selection of successful applicants for the Autumn 2011 Cycle. The Selection Panel was composed of:

2. The Selection Panel considered a total of 216 applications made up of 81 applications from Africa, 69 from Asia/Pacific, 63 from Latin America and Caribbean region and 3 applications from developed consumer countries. Four percent of the applications were in the field of Economic Information and Market Intelligence (EIMI); 10% in the field of Forest Industry (FI) and 86% in the field of Reforestation and Forest Management (RFM). Thirty one percent of the applications were submitted by female applicants.

While reviewing these 216 applications, the Panel used the following selection criteria:

- (i) Consistency of the proposed activities with the ITTO fellowship programme's objective and priority areas;
- (ii) Qualifications of the applicants to undertake the proposed fellowship activities;
- (iii) Applications and benefits of the skills and knowledge to be acquired or advanced under the fellowship activities; and
- (iv) Reasonableness of costs in relation to the proposed activities.
- 3. The Panel took into account the balance among the three subject areas and regions as well as the opportunity to promote the participation of women. The Panel recommends to the Council 48 applicants should be approved, subject to the availability of funds at a total cost of US\$286,595. Women account for 38% of the recommended applicants. Thirty eight percent of the recommended applicants are from Africa, 29% from Asia/Pacific and 33% from Latin America and Caribbean region. The recommended applicants are listed in the Appendix to this report.
- 4. The Panel recommended that nationals of member countries with cumulative arrears in contribution to the Administrative Account should not be eligible for ITTO Fellowship awards.

5. The Selection Panel members for the Year 2012 were also invited to the Panel meeting and were informed of the fellowship selection procedure and timeline for 2012. The 2012 Selection Panel is composed of:
