




AMAZONAS STATE

- 157 million hectares, 1/3 of Brazilian Amazonia
 - 1/5 of China
 - 1,5 times Indonesia
- Annual per capta income
 - Amazonas: US\$ 6.500
- Population of 3,7 million
- World's largest above ground reservoir of fresh water (16%)




GDP Growth and the Deforestation Rate in Amazonas







- Existing Protected Areas ----- 7,4








Climate Change, an unquestionable truth





FLYING RIVERS

- A large tree in the Amazon evaporates up to 300 litres every day.
- For the entire forest region (5.5 million km2), 20 billion tons of water are evaporated each day.
- The State of Amazonas alone exports some 1,7 trillion cubic meters of water to other regions every year
