REPORT OF THE ITTO FELLOWSHIP SELECTION PANEL

(Item 19 of the Provisional Agenda)

 Fellowship selection for 2015 was conducted electronically. However, the Panel met once during the Fifty-first Session of the ITTC to finalize the selection of successful applicants for the Autumn 2015 Cycle. The Selection Panel was composed of:

2. The Selection Panel considered a total of 52 applications made up of 24 applications from Africa, 14 from Asia/Pacific, 12 from Latin America and Caribbean region and 2 from Europe. Four percent of the applications were in the field of Economic Information and Market Intelligence (EIMI); 8% in the field of Forest Industry (FI) and 88% in the field of Reforestation and Forest Management (RFM). Thirty five percent of the applications were submitted by female applicants.

While reviewing these 52 applications, the Panel used the following selection criteria:

- Consistency of the proposed activities with the ITTO fellowship programme's objective and priority areas;
- (ii) Qualifications of the applicants to undertake the proposed fellowship activities;
- (iii) Applications and benefits of the skills and knowledge to be acquired or advanced under the fellowship activities; and
- (iv) Reasonableness of costs in relation to the proposed activities.

The Panel took into account the balance among the three subject areas and regions as well as the opportunity to promote the participation of women. The Panel also took into account the Strategic Action Plan in its selection Process. The Panel recommends to the Council to award 18 fellowships, subject to the availability of funds at a total cost of US\$100,000. Women account for 56% of the recommended applicants. Thirty three percent of the recommended applicants are from Africa, 33% from Asia/Pacific, 28% from Latin America and Caribbean region and 6% from a consumer country for a project in Latin America. The recommended applicants are listed in the Appendix to this report. Also attached is the Fellowship Awardees for the Spring Cycle of 2015.

- 3. The Selection Panel pointed out a necessity to be clear especially on issues such as DSA, book expenses etc. in the criteria guidelines for evaluating candidates. They agreed that budgets exceeding the guidelines should be clearly noted and justified by the evaluator. The selection panel noted the need for the secretariat to assess applications with more rigor at the phase of preselection before sending pre-selected applications to Selection Panel Members.
- 4. The Chairperson of the Panel thanked the outgoing Panel members for their excellent and hard work on selection process.
