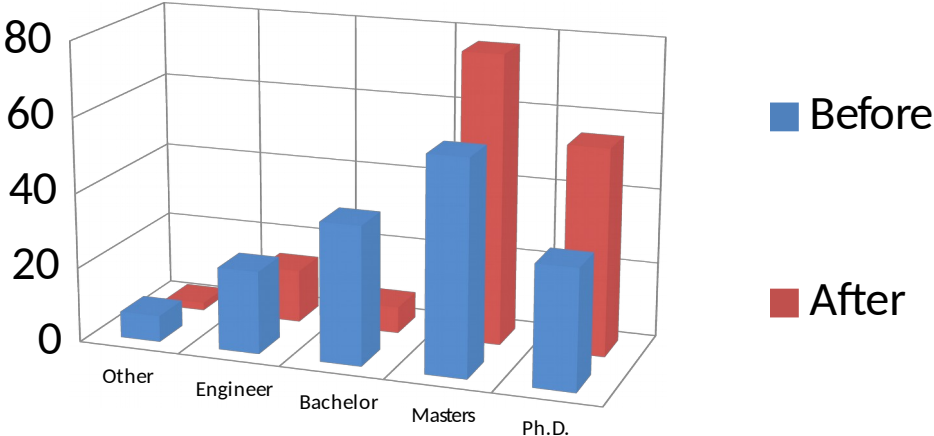


Promotions after fellowship



61% responded that they had obtained a relevant job position or job promotion **immediately** after completing their Fellowship activities.
