- "MALEBI" is an association of women producers and sellers of charcoal and firewood.
- Inception date: 2008
- Main Goals:
 - Combat poverty in families through women empowerment
 - Best Practices on reforestation activities (agroforestry) associated to charcoal production
- ▶ The "MALEBI" Association has the following main areas of intervention:
 - Production of charcoal with modern methods (avoiding waste of resources);
 - Distribution / Transportation / Sales with women (priority to widows)
 - * Reforestation activities to compensate wood used for charcoal production.

IMPACT / RESULTS / ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

- Capacity building of women in rural area on:
 - Establishment of nurseries
 - Agro-forestry plantation (crops combined with trees)
- Reforestation activities for gradual rehabilitation of Ahua Gazetted Forest, in Cote d'Ivoire)
- World Bank Forest Investment Programme (FIP) for continuation
