







Forest Distribution from sea to mountain in Thailand



Total Forest Area 102 million rai (6.25 rai = 1 ha)
Approximately 33 % of total Land Area of the county



National Policy on Forest Management Target


Total Forest Area 128 million Rai (6.25 ria = 1 ha)
Minimum Forest Area 40% of the total area of the country

Total Area 80 million rai (25%)

Total Area 48 million rai (15%)



Areas Plantation by Species of Forest industry Organization (FIO) and Private Sector



Other National Potential Area Permitted by cabinet for Tree planting (supported by New Acts)

- Land reform for agriculture 50,000,000 rai
- Land tittle for community 3,000,000 rai
