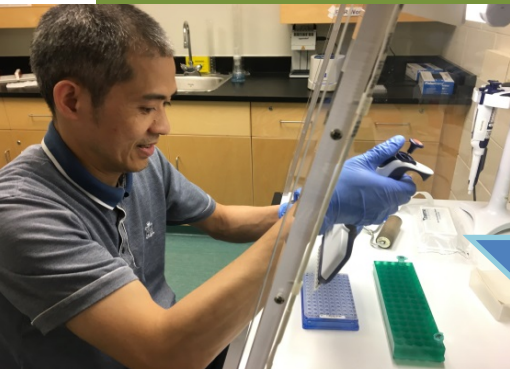

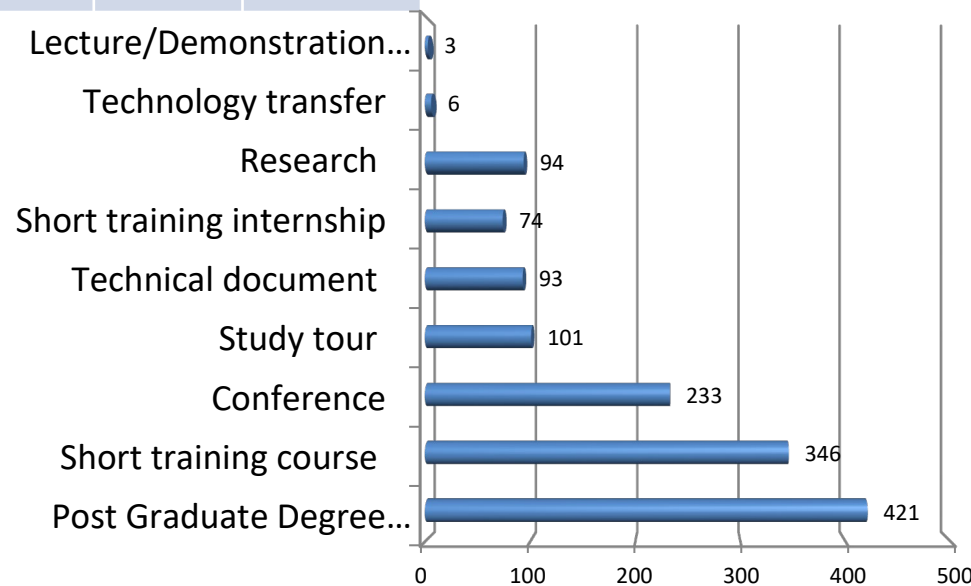


The total number of fellowships awarded until now : **1,393**

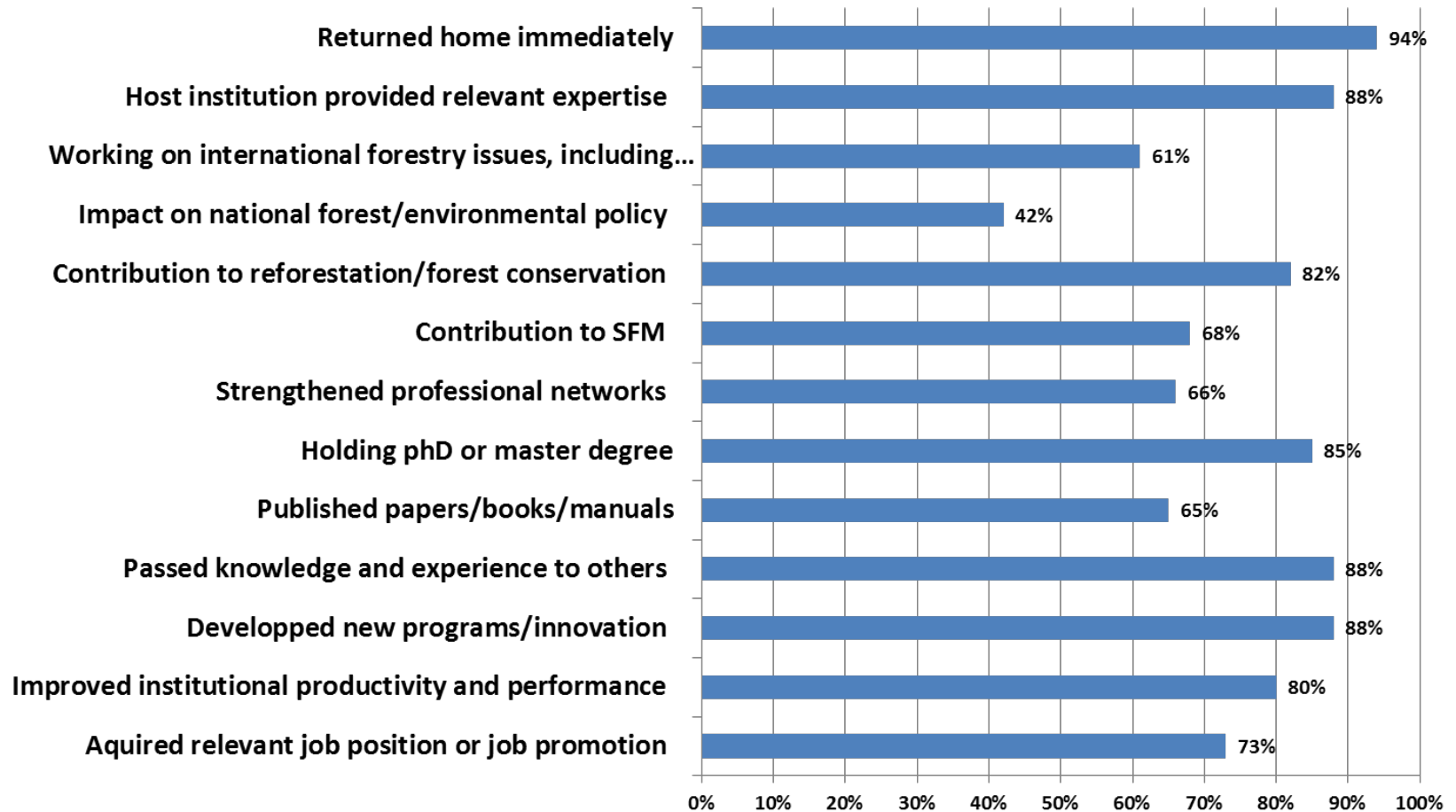

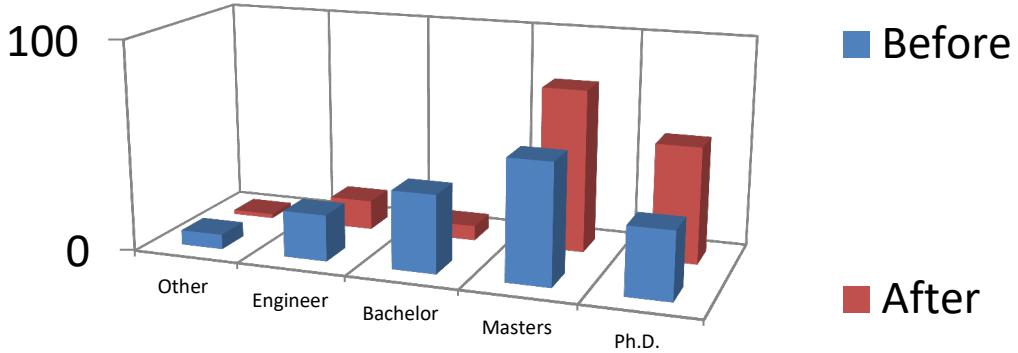


Promotions after fellowship



61% responded that they had obtained a relevant job position or job promotion **immediately** after completing their Fellowship activities.

73% of respondents answered “totally related” or “strongly related” to the question of whether any **job promotion** or **new job position** they had obtained was due to the skill or knowledge they gained from the Fellowship
