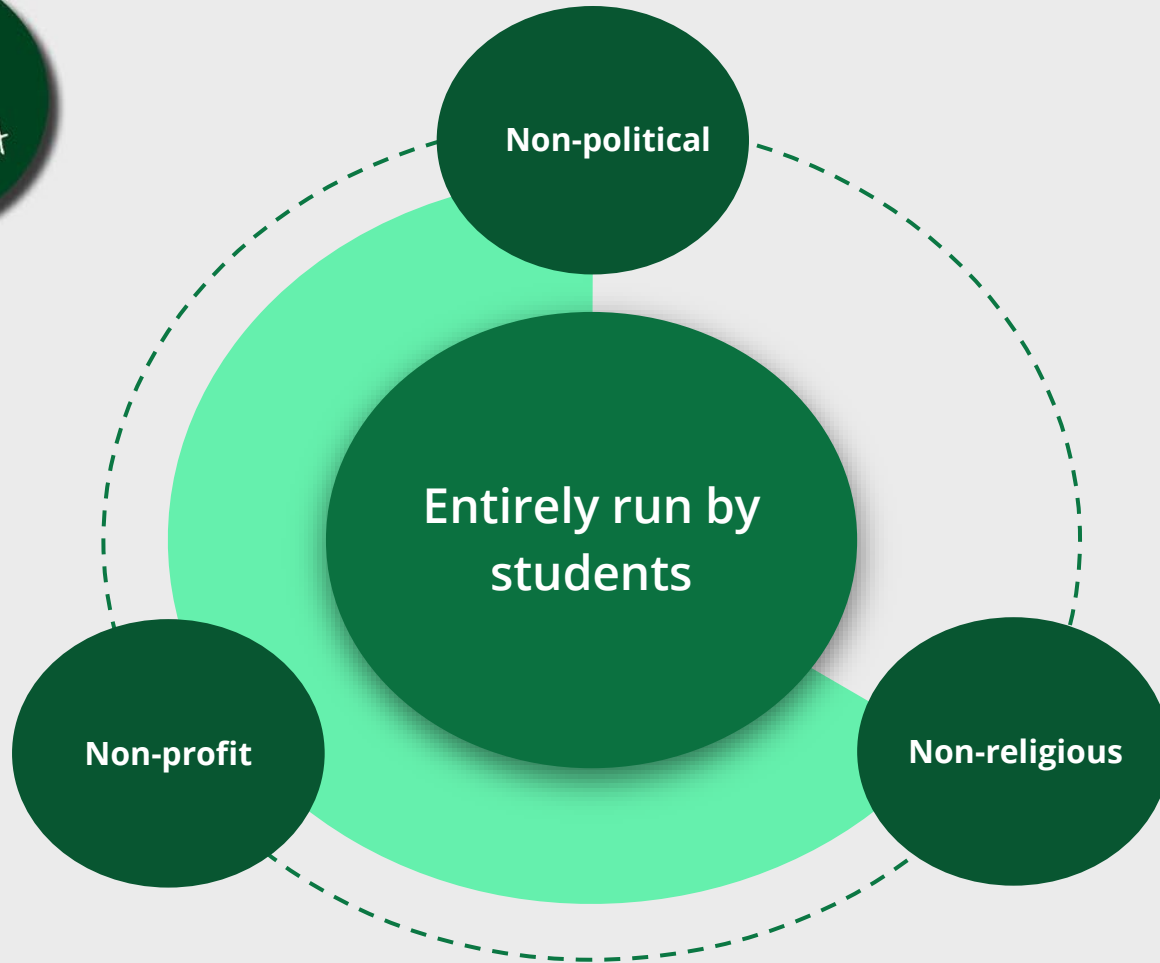

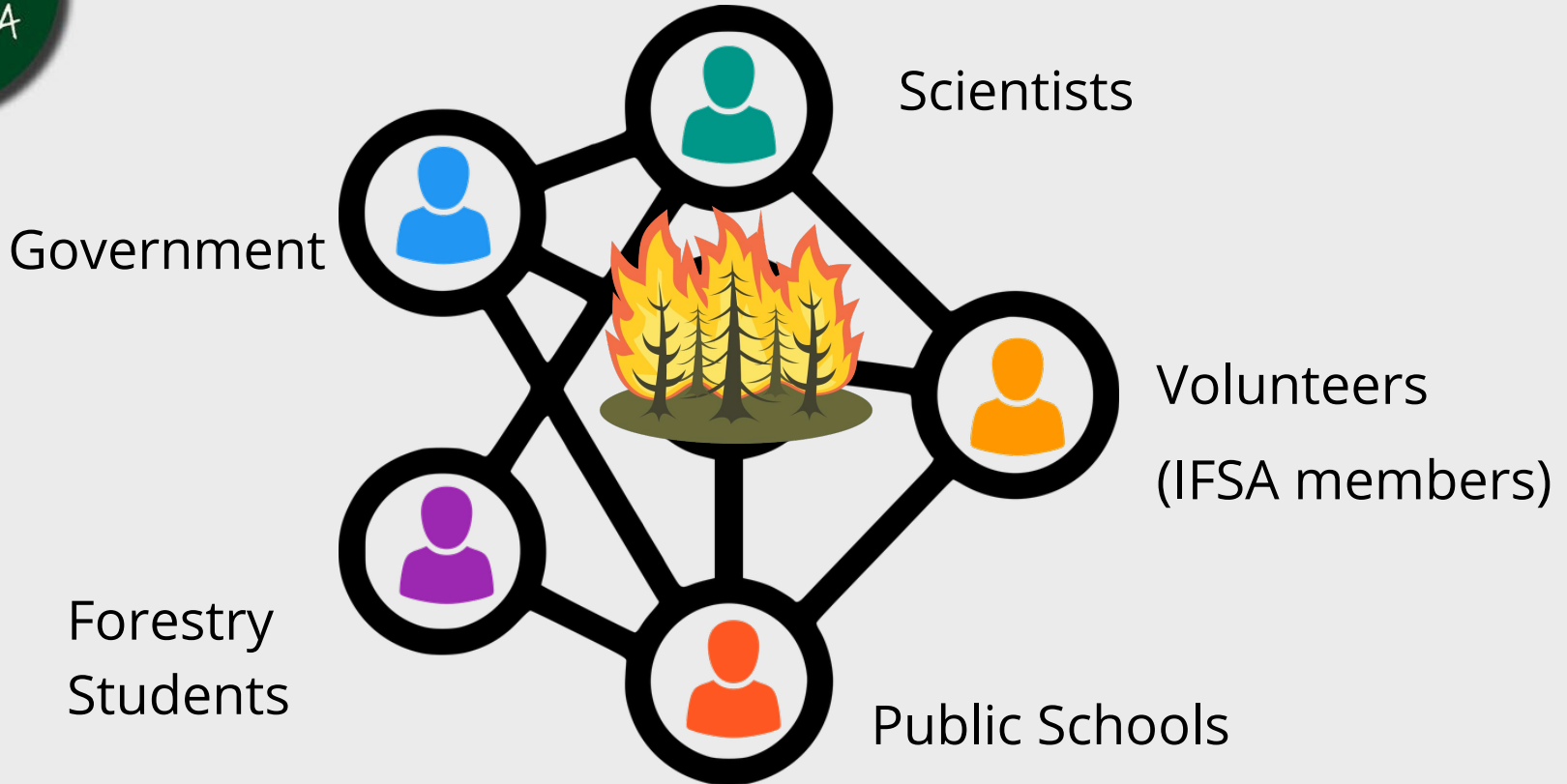


Education: Children and youth
