Denmark

Article 27/5. If a member has not furnished, for two consecutive years, the statistics and information required under paragraph 3 and has not sought the assistance of the Executive Director, the Executive Director shall initially request an explanation from that member within a specified time. In the event that no satisfactory explanation is forthcoming, the Council shall take such action as it deems appropriate.



JQ 2022 Data Quality

- 40 countries submitted consistent data on production of wood products
- All countries submitted data on trade of primary wood products
- 38 countries submitted data on trade of secondary wood products
- Only 18 countries provided information on production and trade of primary wood products for the year 2022 (sheet ITTO1)
- Only 19 countries provided trade on tropical species (sheet ITTO2)
- Only 14 countries provided insights on their forestry sector (sheet ITTO3)
- 25 countries were on time (30-Sept-2022)



Database developments

- Updated twice a year (Feb. and Aug.)
- Conversion factors study for tropical logs and sawnwood was published in 2021
- Biennial Review 2021-2022 will include:
 - Long-term review of tropical wood products consumption and trade
 - Study of the efficiency of the wood processing industries in the African region is currently under discussion.




PRODUCTION AND TRADE TRENDS PRIMARY WOOD PRODUCTS






World imports of tropical primary products, 1990-2022






Production of tropical logs by region, 2013-2022






Major exporters of tropical logs, 2013-2022





Major importers of tropical logs, 2013-2022






West Africa Log Export Price Index





Production of tropical sawnwood, by major ITTO producer country, 2013-2022




MAJOR TRADE FLOWS 2021: TROPICAL SAWNWOOD






Tropical sawnwood exports, major tropical countries, 2013-2022





Tropical sawnwood imports, major ITTO countries 2013-2022






West Africa Sawnwood Export Price Index





Production of tropical plywood, by major country, 2013-2022






Major exporters of tropical plywood, 2013-2022






World imports of secondary processed wood products, 2013-2022






SPWP imports, by major ITTO importer, 2013-2022






SPWP exports, by major ITTO producer, 2013-2022






Real GDP growth, 2000-2027


ITTO Producer Regions
