Forest & Timber Certification

- Total certified forest area of ITTO Producing Members as of 2021 (FSC+PEFC):
 - 36.4 Million Ha
 - 6.5% of the world total (546 Million Ha)
- Chain of Custody (CoC) certification of ITTO Producing Members as of 2021 (FSC+PEFC):
 - 5,484 certificates
 - 8.4% of the world total (52,315 certificates)



Forest & Timber Certification

- Two international certification systems, **FSC** and **PEFC**, continued to be the main schemes being implemented in ITTO producing member countries.
- **PEFC** remained as the largest certification scheme in the world (60%).
- **FSC** accounted more share (near 60%) of certified forests in ITTO producing members.



FSC Facts & Figures (2021)



- FSC certified forest areas in ITTO producing members:
 - 21.2 mHa, minor decrease
 - 9% of the global FSC certified areas
- FSC in world 2021: 230.7 mHa, increased 8.9 mHa
- Top 3 ITTO producing members of FSC certified areas:
 - Brazil (7.96m), Indonesia (3.15), and Ro Congo (2.99)
 - 67% of total of ITTO producing members



FSC Facts & Figures (2021)



- FSC CoC in ITTO producing members:
 - **4,928** certificates, +11.4%
 - **9.4%** of **FSC CoC** (52,717)
- Top 3 ITTO producing members of FSC CoC:
 - Vietnam (1,213, +15%), Brazil (1,187), India (1,143, +14%)
 - 72% of total of ITTO producing members



FSC Developments in 2021 General Assembly



- FSC 2020 General Assembly was postponed and was taking place in two parts:
 - > 25-29 October 2021 virtual
 - 9-14 October 2022 hybrid in Bali
- The FSC GA has adopted a number of Motions with significant changes during its recent sessions.
 - ➤ 2021 virtual: 3 passed.
 - 2022 hybrid: 15 passed.
- ITTO was represented and served on panel discussion at FSC GA.



FSC Developments in 2021 General Assembly



- FSC 2021/2022 General Assembly: 2021 virtual
 - ➤ Motion 20/2020: Climate Emergency
 - ✓ Calls for climate change and biodiversity loss to be placed at the center of implementing FSC global strategy
 - ➤ Motion 48/2021: Improve ecosystem services procedure
 - ➤ Motion 61/2021: Create and publish a digital map of FSC certified forests worldwide
 - ✓ Requires the publication of maps of certified concessions (on a voluntary basis)



FSC Developments in 2022 General Assembly



- FSC 2021/2022 General Assembly: 2022 Hybrid in Bali, 15 motions passed, 2 most relevant to tropical timber producers:
 - ➤ Motion 23/2020: Use landscape-wide approaches adapted to local conditions and strengthen Standard Development Groups (SDGs) to improve protection of Intact Forest Landscapes.
 - ✓ A boost to certification of tropical forest concessions operating in "intact forest landscapes" as long as they carry out SFM
 - ➤ Motion 37/2021: Required changes to the FSC Principles and Criteria to implement the Policy to Address Conversion
 - ✓ Make changes to the FSC Principles and Criteria to enable implementation of the Policy to Address Conversion, provide market incentives to restore deforested/degraded land.
 - ✓ Moved the cutoff date for when land could be cleared for plantations and still have plantation forests/products certified from 1994 when FSC was first established to 2020.
 - ✓ Allow more such forests/plantations to be certified in the tropics where many plantations were established in this period.



PEFC Facts & Figures (2021)



- **PEFC** certified forest areas in ITTO producing members:
 - **15.1** mHa, increased 0.55 mHa
 - 4.6% of the global PEFC certified areas (mHa)
- **PEFC** in world 2021: 328.5 mHa, increased 4 mHa
- 6 ITTO producing members have PEFC certified areas:
 - Malaysia (5.31m), Brazil (4.71m, +10.6), Indonesia (4.02m), Gabon (0.60m), and India (0.45m),
 Vietnam (46,000 ha)



PEFC Facts & Figures (2021)



- PEFC CoC in ITTO producing members:
 - 556 certificates
 - **4.4%** of FSC CoC (12,671)
- **Top 3** ITTO producing members of PEFC CoC:
 - Malaysia (372), Indonesia (41), Brazil (35)
 - 80% of total of ITTO producing members



PEFC Developments in 2021



- PEFC-certified hectares grew by nearly 4 m, 14% from ITTO producers
- Pan African Forest Certification (PAFC) Congo Basin regional system achieved PEFC endorsement.
- PAFC Congo Basin became the world's first PEFCendorsed regional forest certification system.
- Vietnam achieved first certified forest area in PEFC.
- 3 ITTO producers, Myanmar, Guyana, and Ghana are PEFC non-endorsed members.

9 National Certification Schemes Endorsed by PEFC as of 2021



- Brazil: Brazilian Forest Certification Programme (CERFLOR)
- Malaysia: Malaysian Timber Certification Council (MTCC)
- Indonesia: Indonesian Forestry Certification Coop (IFCC)

- India: Network for Certification&Conservation of Forests(NCCF)
- Vietnam: Vietnam Forest Certification Office (VFCO)
- Cameroon: Cameroonian Association of PAFC
- Republic of Congo: PAFC-Congo
- Thailand: The Federation of Thai Industries (F.T.I.)
- Ghana, Guyana, Myanmar (non-endorsed members)
