





Updated Information on Forest & Timber Certification in ITTO Producing Members (2022)

- Total certified forest area of ITTO Producing Members as of 2022 (FSC+PEFC):
 - 38.1 Million Ha
 - **8.5%** of the world total (448 Million Ha), 2% increase due to decrease of world total
- Chain of Custody (CoC) certification of ITTO Producing Members as of 2022 (FSC+PEFC):
 - 6,010 certificates
 - **8.6%** of the world total (69,704 certificates)

- Two international certification systems, FSC and PEFC, continued to be the main schemes being implemented in ITTO producing member countries.
- PEFC remained as the largest certification scheme in the world (64%).
- FSC accounted more share (near 59%) of certified forests in ITTO producing members.





- **FSC** certified forest areas in ITTO producing members:
 - 22.4 mHa, 5.6% increase
 - 14% of the global FSC certified areas (5% increase than 2021 due to decrease of world total, caused by certification suspension of conflict areas)
- **FSC** in world 2022: 160.3 mHa, decreased 70.4 mHa
- **Top 3** ITTO producing members of FSC certified areas:
 - Brazil (8.28m), Indonesia (3.36), and the Congo (2.99)
 - **65%** of total of ITTO producing members





- **FSC CoC** in ITTO producing members:
 - **5,465** certificates
 - 10.8% of FSC CoC (57,178)
- **Top 3** ITTO producing members of FSC CoC:
 - Vietnam (1,580, +23%), Brazil (1,200), India (1,188)
 - 73% of total of ITTO producing members





- Issued updates to FSC's Controlled Wood Framework
- Implement measures related to FSC certificate ceasing material from Russia, Belarus and conflict areas in Ukraine and certificates suspended.
- FSC organized two events to discuss the implications of EUDR, especially focusing on the new requirement of geolocation of wood.
- Part 2 of FSC General Assembly 2021-2022 was held on 9-14
 October 2022, 15 motions discussed and passed.





- **PEFC** certified forest areas in ITTO producing members:
 - **15.7** mHa, slightly increased 0.52 mHa
 - **5.4%** of the global PEFC certified areas (mHa)
- **PEFC** in world 2022: 288.2 mHa, decreased 40 mHa
- 6 ITTO producing members have PEFC certified areas:
 - Malaysia (5.7m), Brazil (4.7m), Indonesia (3.8m),
 Gabon (0.9m, +49%), and India (0.45m), Vietnam (0.1m)





- **PEFC CoC** in ITTO producing members:
 - **545** certificates
 - 4.4% of FSC CoC (12,526)
- **Top 3** ITTO producing members of PEFC CoC:
 - Malaysia (341), Indonesia (48), Vietnam (43)
 - **79%** of total of ITTO producing members







- PEFC-certified hectares significantly decreased by nearly 40m, 12.3% in the world, but increase 0.5m in ITTO producers.
- Most notable change of certified area occurred due to the suspension of the PEFC systems for Russia and Belarus, leading to a loss of 39 million certified hectares together.
- Africa (Gabon) and Asia (Malaysia and Vietnam) contributed the significant increase of ITTO producers.
- 3 ITTO producers, Ghana, Guyana and Myanmar, are PEFC non-endorsed members.
