## Criteria: seven thematic elements of SFM

#### Adapting the ITTO C&I to the African context

- Tailoring ITTO's Global set of C&I for the African context involved significant changes, including an increase in the total number of indicators from 58 to 94:
- Criterion 1: Enabling conditions for sustainable forest management (17 indicators versus 11 in 2016 ITTO C&I)
- $\succ$  Criterion 2: Extent and condition of forests (10 versus 8)
- $\succ$  Criterion 3: Forest ecosystem health and resilience (13 versus 5)
- Criterion 4: Forest production (18 versus 10)
- Criterion 5: Forest biological diversity (10 versus 7)
- $\blacktriangleright$  Criterion 6: Soil and water protection (7 versus 5)
- $\blacktriangleright$  Criterion 7: Economic, social and cultural aspects (19 versus 12)
