



Developing the First Certified Forest in Private Plantations

- Initiating the certification process for private plantations to create the first-ever certified forest in Myanmar.
- Accrediting Certification Bodies (Myanmar Forest Certification Scheme-MFCS): Collaborating on a joint assessment between the Myanmar Accreditation Body (MAB) and the Vietnam Accreditation Body (BoA of Vietnam) to achieve accreditation.

Expanding Digitalization of Timber Tracking Systems (DTTS) Extending DTTS from a single-station setup to multiple stations and transitioning from postactivity tracing to real-time tracking.





- The additional audit fees of USD 7840.37 is to be returned to ITTC
 - been for 41 Months, The actual balance will be only USD 17,375.6
- The balance will be applied for the devopment of the first-ever plantation in Myanmar.
- For this aim, the accreditation of CB shall be the activities inverse. Bureau of Vietnam BoA and providing ISO 17021 Training.
- Capacity Building and awareness raising workshops related stakeholders.
