Activity 1.1.3 - the presentation of the project activity was performed, history of creation of the reserve (Maués State Forest) and the current situation of the protected area, on 15 and 16 of August 2012, at the Museum of Man in the city of Maués. It was attended by 35 representatives of the Forest communities and partner institutions.

JOSÉ ADILSON VIEIRA DE JESUS: President of the IPDA welcomed the participants of the event, thanked the presence of all, especially the presence of Mayor Carlos Garcia, community representatives and other institutions that were present in the activity. Then he presented the agenda of the event, which aimed to present the project, the history of the Maués State Forest and the reserves' current situation. This activity is part of the Output 1: Strengthening of Community Organizations for the realization of Community Forest Management Project. And execution of the output 1.1 Organizing two meetings to discuss the legal status of the Maués State Forest (rights of communities and decision-making processes).

FABRICIO HERNANI TINTO Project coordinator: Presented the Project Community Forest Management: A Sustainable Alternative for the Maues State Forest. Which is a project between the International Tropical Timber Organization - ITTO, Government of Brazil; Brazilian Cooperation Agency / Ministry of Foreign Affairs - ABC / MRE and the Executing Agency The Amazonian Research and Development Institute - IPDA. The project's goal is to contribute to the sustainable development of the Brazilian Amazon; strengthen the process of implementation of community forestry as a means to



promote sustainable development of the communities of the Maués State Forest. It will benefit 19 communities in 04 rivers in an area of 438,440.32 hectares. Main activities to be developed are: 1) Strengthening of Community Organizations for the realization of the Project; 2) prepared and approved Forest Management Plans; 3) Working Group prepared to effectively manage community forest enterprises. Results: Three Forest Management Plans drawn up; Tropical Timber Market study updated and Business Plan Drafting. He said the government representative would talk about the creation and the current situation of the forest, as well as everyone present could tell a little about the history of the reservation. He asked for full commitment of all communities, stressing that without their commitment this project will not have the expected result. But with their participation we have all the conditions to improve the life of all, in the environmental, social and economic aspects.

IRANILDO CURSINO Representative of CEUC / SDS: thanked the Institute for inviting the Secretariat to be part of this activity, he spoke of the importance of the project and reiterated to those present that the project was an achievement for the reservation communities. This reserve has a great potential for timber and non-timber products, this can generate wealth for the inhabitants of the protected area. The SDS in charge coordinated for almost two years all discussions for the creation of the Maués State Forest, culminating in 2003 with the creation of Conservation Units - CU, through **Decree No. 23,540, of July 19, 2003**, as Art . 1 created the Maués State Forest, located in the State of Amazonas, with the objective of promoting the management of the use of multiple natural resources, maintenance and protection of water resources and biodiversity, land reclamation, environmental education, and support the sustainable development of local communities and the municipality of Maués. The protected area is made up of 24 residents communities and 19 surrounding communities. Under federal and state law created the Advisory Board of the State Forest Maués, through **Ordinance / SDS / n ° 002/2010 of 26 January 2010**, which is composed of federal, state, local and social movements , and the duties of members, the organization and functioning of the board are set out in Internal Regulations. The State Forest also has the State Plan Management, the board approved and published through **Ordinance / SDS / nº 046/2012**, and it must be reviewed every two years. He said the Mother of the Maués State Forest Association received through the Institute of the Amazon Lands - ITEAM the **Concession Real Right of Use - Collective CDRU** of the constant state of Amazonas area of land in the protected area, the five-term years. Currently the management of the State Forest is performed by SDS, through the State Center for Conservation Units - CEUC, communities are benefited with some benefits of Bolsa Floresta from the Amazonas State Government

MAYOR FATHER CARLOS GOES: He thanked the presence of all, expressing his satisfaction to receive the IPDA team in the city. He said the municipal government has increased interest in supporting the project, since it relates to jobs and income for communities. So the executing agency and partners can count on him and on the Maués City Hall.



AMELIA DE SOUZA GOMES: President of the Union of Rural Workers of Maués. The reserve now has a "MOTHER" association which is the Association of Agroextractive Producers of the Maués State Forest - ASPAFEMP, she said that for her who was a resident of Parauari River with ten (10) communities involved in the project it will be of great value to the social organization, and especially generation of income, the forest is valuable, we have other products such as chestnut, vine, fish, guarana, after all, our county is the land of guarana, we need to explore other species. When I say explore, my companions, I say it in a good sense. I congratulate the IPDA, who I have known for a long time, know the technical capacity of mobilization and coordination of partners. The Union is willing to contribute to the project execution. I attended all the discussions for the creation of the reserve, the creation of the reserve was through the urging of community, social movements and the initiative of the State Government to support us. At the time the Pastoral Land Commission - CPT, with the Movement of Working Riparian Women - MMTR-AM were fundamental in discussions for the creation of the reserve.

AGENOR CORREA MOTA: Representative of São Sebastião Community. He said that as a resident of the State Forest it is the first time that he participates in the project activities, and stated how glad he is to know the technical team of IPDA, and said that his community is open to receive the project. After nearly ten years of creation of the reserve, it is important to make investments like this project in the reservation, as it will contribute to the development of the State Forest. After all that's why the reservation was created in 2003 to bring these benefits to the people who live in the Forest.

MARIA ITANILDE BARBOSA ANDRADE: Representative of the Parauari River Residents Association. Congratulated the mayor, Adilson Vieira president of IPDA, Iranildo Cursino of CEUC / SDS, and especially community representatives. She noted that seeing Coordinator Fabricio present the project and to finally witness the coming of this project for the city is a blessing from God, she also said it makes her very happy to know that the Institute will develop such an important project and that her community is also in full agreement with the project implementation, it will help in improving the income of residents of the protected area.

DECRETO N.º 23.540, DE 19 DE JULHO DE 2003.

CRIA e delimita a FLORESTA ESTADUAL DE MAUÉS, localizada no Município de Maués, no Estado do Amazonas, e dá outras providências.

O GOVERNADOR DO ESTADO DO AMAZONAS, no exercício da competência que lhe confere o artigo 54, VIII, da Constituição Estadual, e

CONSIDERANDO o marco legal estabelecido pelo Sistema Nacional de Unidades de Conservação no que diz respeito a unidades de conservação de uso sustentável;

CONSIDERANDO a importância estratégica das Florestas Estaduais para a promoção do desenvolvimento sustentável do Estado do Amazonas a partir de sistemas de manejo florestal madeireiro e não-madeireiro por comunidades locais, e pequenas, médias e grandes empresas florestais;

CONSIDERANDO que essas unidades de manejo sustentável são categorias de unidades de proteção dos atributos naturais, admitida a exploração dos recursos disponíveis em regime de manejo sustentável, sujeito às limitações legais;

CONSIDERANDO os estudos realizados pelo Instituto de Proteção Ambiental do Amazonas-IPAAAM e o Município de Maués para criação dessa unidade de conservação na região do Rio Apocaitana;

CONSIDERANDO que na área predomina cobertura florestal nativa importante para conservação da biodiversidade, cujo uso deve ser efetivado através de tecnologias sustentáveis;

CONSIDERANDO a necessidade de promover a melhoria da qualidade de vida das populações tradicionais residentes na área, com inserção de novas tecnologias de uso sustentável dos recursos naturais;

CONSIDERANDO, finalmente, que, por determinação do artigo 225, III, da Constituição Federal, combinado com o inciso do artigo 229 e com o artigo 230, V, da Constituição Estadual, todos têm direito ao meio ambiente ecologicamente equilibrado, bem de uso comum do povo e essencial à sadia qualidade de vida, impondo-se ao Poder Público e à coletividade o dever de defendê-lo e preservá-lo para as presentes e futuras gerações e que, para assegurar a efetividade desse direito, incumbe-lhe definir espaços territoriais e seus componentes a serem especialmente protegidos.

D E C R E T A :

Art. 1.º - Fica criada a FLORESTA ESTADUAL DE MAUÉS, localizada no Município de Maués, no Estado do Amazonas, com os objetivos de promover o manejo de uso múltiplos recursos naturais, a manutenção e a proteção dos recursos hídricos e da biodiversidade, a recuperação de áreas degradadas, a educação ambiental, bem como o apoio ao desenvolvimento sustentável das comunidades locais e do Município de Maués.

§ 1.º - A FLORESTA deverá comportar áreas de diferentes dimensões para comunidades locais, pequenas, médias e grandes empresas florestais, na forma a ser descrita no plano de manejo.

§ 2.º - As comunidades locais residentes na Floresta Estadual e entorno terão seus direitos assegurados na forma estabelecida pela legislação que dispõe sobre as Unidades de Conservação, com regulamentação no plano de manejo.

Art. 2.º - A FLORESTA ESTADUAL DE MAUÉS possui uma área total aproximada de 438.440,32 ha, descrita com base nas folhas MIR-117 e MIR-141, da 4ª DL/PAAM, escala 1:250.000, com o seguinte memorial descritivo: inicia-se junto ao Ponto 01, em direção Noroeste, de coordenadas geográficas aproximadas de 3º49'19" S e 58º17'34" W de Gr, deste ponto descendo pela margem direita do Paraná Urariá até o Ponto 02, de coordenadas geográficas aproximadas de 03º40'48" S e 58º12'00" W de Gr, deste ponto seguindo numa linha reta até o Ponto 03, localizado na confluência do Rio Apocaitana com o Igarapé Pacoval, de coordenadas geográficas aproximadas de 03º45'36" S e 57º40'12" W de Gr, deste ponto subindo pela margem esquerda do Igarapé Cikaná até o Ponto 04, de coordenadas geográficas aproximadas de 03º45'36" S e 57º40'12" W de Gr, deste ponto segue numa linha reta até o Ponto 05 de coordenadas geográficas aproximadas de 03º43'48" S e 57º34'12" W de Gr, deste ponto segue pela margem direita de Igarapé sem denominação até a sua confluência com o Rio Paraitari no Ponto 06, de coordenadas geográficas de 03º43'48" S e 57º32'24" W de Gr, próximo a comunidade São João Batista, deste ponto acompanhando a margem esquerda do Rio Paraitari até o Ponto 07, de coordenadas geográficas de 04º08'24" S e 57º36'36" W de Gr, deste ponto seguindo numa linha reta até o Ponto 08, correspondendo ao Ponto 07 da gleba Alfredo Guimarães, de coordenadas geográficas 04º14'17" S e 57º30'00" W de Gr, deste ponto seguindo numa linha reta até o Ponto 9, correspondendo ao ponto 08 da gleba Alfredo Guimarães de coordenadas geográficas 04º00'00" S e 58º07'51" W de Gr, deste ponto seguindo numa linha reta até o Ponto 10, correspondendo ao ponto 9 da gleba Alfredo Guimarães de coordenadas geográficas 04º00'00" S e 58º07'51" W de Gr, deste ponto seguindo numa linha reta até o Ponto 01, ponto inicial desta descritiva, correspondente ao ponto 10, da gleba Alfredo Guimarães de coordenadas geográficas aproximadas de 03º49'19" S e 58º17'34" W de Gr, matriculada em nome do Estado do Amazonas, em 24 de maio de 1982, sob o n.º 1.024, no livro 2-4, as folhas 105, no Cartório do Primeiro Ofício da Comarca de Maués.

Art. 3.º - A gestão da FLORESTA ESTADUAL DE MAUÉS será realizada pela Secretaria de Estado do Meio Ambiente e Desenvolvimento Sustentável - SDS, por intermédio da Agência de Florestas e Negócios Sustentáveis.



Art. 4.º - O Secretário de Estado do Meio Ambiente e Desenvolvimento Sustentável aprovava, mediante Instrução Normativa, o Plano de Manejo da FLORESTA ESTADUAL DE MAUÉS, devendo ser elaborado no prazo máximo de cinco anos, a contar da publicação deste Decreto.







Activity 1.2.3 - was held in Manaus on 3 and 4 of June, 2013, two meetings with the technical team of project, partner institutions, and project beneficiaries of the Maués Forest communities on the concepts of forms of association.

ADILSON VIEIRA - IPDA: The President initiated the meeting by thanking the presence of all, thanked the support of the SDS to assign a space for the IPDA to carry out the activities, and asked the Advisory Coordinator Mr. Aginaldo Queiroz to make a general presentation of the project, as some of the attendees had not participated in previous activities. He noted that in this activity it needs to be held two meetings on the concepts of forms of associations (3 and 4 of June) and then they will participate in the environmental week activities, he wished all a good event.

AGINALDO QUEIROZ - IPDA: Thanked the presence of all, said the presence of the inhabitants of the protected area is of fundamental importance for the strengthening of the reserve organizations, the IPDA has the support of everyone for the success of project activities. Then gave an overview of the project, along with coordinator Fabricio Tinto presented the concepts of forms of association. The associations are regulated by the Civil Code, each association has its own characteristic, *'Art. 53. Constitute associations by the union of people who are organized for non-profit, single paragraph. There aren't, among the members, reciprocal rights and obligations. "Soon the Association is nothing more than a kind of legal entity of private law. The Association, in order to exist, needs a status, which are the rules for its administration, the statute must contain at least the entity name, its purposes and headquarters; requirements for admission and associated exclusion; rights and associated obligations; sources of funds for their maintenance; form of constitution and functioning of the governing and administrative bodies. After preparing the statute needs to be registered in the Civil Registry of Legal Entities.*

Advantages of the Associations Organization:

- 1) The first advantage of the organization of residents to better protect conservation areas is that decisions are legitimized by the community;
- 2) The organization also allows decisions on the conservation of natural resources and are taken in a democratic way, through the participation of stakeholders;
- 3) Another advantage is that with the organization of the residents it is easier to pass on information and harmonize the understanding of messages;
- 4) The biggest advantage, however, is the potential of the Community of sum that become a transforming force;

Then the project coordinator gave opportunity for the attendees to ask questions or contribute to anything that was said.

JOSE GINANILDO RODRIGUES CAVALCANTE: He congratulated the speaker, and said he believes in the organization of civil society, and that the reservation has several organizations,

the Mother organization is representing the residents of units, and through mother association, is that the reservation had several achievement as Concession the Right to Use (CDRU) board creation of the reserve, Bolsa Floresta, Exchange Association, Income Grant and now sustainable forest management project that the IPDA is bringing to the reserve.

MARIA IVETE DE OLIVEIRA: She appreciated the invitation, saying that it is the first time she took part of the project activity, she noted how she enjoyed the lecture given by the coordinator and she believes that the association is an organization tool for the reservation, and it is very important to acknowledge this information, because more can be learned and spread to the residents of her community.

SERGIO PAULO ROQUE: Stated that for them in the union, it is good to attend meetings that helps their work, because it guides the way they work in the reserve. And speaking about concepts of associations is talking about social strengthening the communities. So he thanked IPDA for the meeting.

The Coordinator thanked the presence of all and said the project's role is to strengthen community to manage the community project.

The meeting was attended by 29 participants, with a hourly load of 12 hours, the activity was held in the center of events in Studio 5 in Manaus



This meeting is part of the project "Community Forest Management of the Maués State Forest." Institutions that participated in the event: Unions of Workers and Rural Workers in Maués - STRM, Movement of Working Riparian Women - MMTR-AM, representatives of Cicantá River, representatives of River Parauari association, representatives of Pacoval River Association, Apoquitaua River Association and Amazonian Research and Development Institute - IPDA.

FABRICIO HERNANI TINTO: Project coordinator initiates the meeting talking about general and simplified concept, "we can say that leadership is the process of conducting a group of people, turning it into a team that generates results. It is the ability to motivate and influence the team in a positive and ethical way, and voluntarily contribute enthusiastically to achieve the goals of the team and the organization. "Then the coordinator presented the methodology used in the meeting such as: group work, PowerPoint presentation and discussion. The coordinator spoke about the types of leader: Leader Style:

Autocratic style (Authoritarian):

Leading fixed guidelines, without any participation of the group..

- The leader determines the measures and techniques for the task (what to do, how, when, etc.).
- The leader determines which task that each must perform and who is their co-worker.
- The leader is dominating and it's (personal) in praise and criticism on the work of each subordinate (points and criticized directly to the person without any care for the use of words in order to not offend)

DEMOCRATIC STYLE:

- The guidelines are debated and decided by the group. The leader's role is to assist and encourage and not to impose. It is the group that defines the techniques for accomplishing objectives, requesting technical advice to the leader when necessary, suggesting two or more alternatives for the group to choose. The tasks take on a new dimension as they are successfully debated. The leader is a support.
- It is the group that decides on the division of labor and each member has the freedom to choose their co-worker;
- The leader seeks to be a member of the group and not act superior to the others, not taking on too many tasks. The leader is straight forward and when criticizes and praises, he is limited to the facts.

Soon after the coordinator's presentation, the workshop was opened for questions and contributions from participants. The union representative said that she enjoyed the seminar and stated that this style of leaders exist in their institutions, she said "I feel like a democratic leader." To the representative of Cicanta River Association, the lecture was clear and objective. For the representative of the São Marcos community, as a resident of Forest it is the first time that he attends the meeting and liked the lecture, the speaker was clear and objective. After hearing all contributions, the coordinator talks about the importance of community participation, participation from them is also a form of leadership. And stated how this topic will be of relevance to the continuation of the project.

Conclusion:

Leadership in an organization has been the focus of attention for many years. The topic can have several definitions, but in all of them there is an emphasis on **influencing each other into operating a task completely and satisfactorily**. There were times when it was believed that a leader was born leader; nowadays, it is more than proven that this does not happen that way because there is no direct relationship between a personality trait and being a leader. The leadership process varies depending on the situation causing someone to be good leader in a given situation.

This theory presents three leadership styles: autocratic, democratic and liberal. Each of these styles has its own characteristics and different consequences in a group. Of the three leadership styles presented, we conclude that the group that produces more work is an Autocratic leadership, but has a greater quality of work in a Democratic leadership.

FABRICIO HERNANI TINTO: As the meeting was reaching its end, he noted “ I'm glad to be here to inform that this project is being funded by ABC, ITTO in partnership with the State Government and local organizations. Thanks to Mrs. Amelia who's President of the Association for their support and the presence of forest residents, which are critical to the project's success”. He also said that It was a great, productive, and successful meeting and thanked all who accepted the invitation made by IPDA consequently closing the meeting.






