


Export Log Prices





Price Movements

Export log prices in the second quarter have not shown any significant improvement over the levels achieved in the first three months of the year, this despite some falling stock levels as a result of poor weather conditions.

Meranti has been moving in a narrow range of US\$205-215. N'Gollon and Sapelli have been moving at lower US dollar prices reflecting the strengthening of the dollar against the Franc.

South Sea log prices are largely unchanged but changes taking place in the log Royalty levels in PNG and the reaction of industry needs to be closely monitored in the coming months








Sawnwood shippments from S.E.Asia to Japan have been quiet. Prices for laminated lumber have increased but the trade in Japan is facing difficulty in passing on the price increases.

In Brazil millers are sill reporting a dull international market. The expected improvement in local consumption has not materialised and shippers are reporting that the MERCOSUL and Caribbean countries are still offering the best prospects.




