Considerable quantities of Pine logs are entering Thailand from Laos. Merchants are complaining of serious insect and fungal infestation in the pine shipments. This is reportedly the result of the long time taken to extract the logs after felling and inadequate log treatment.

Report from Indonesia

The supply of logs is still affected by the poor weather conditions. Many mills are operating at low capacity and some are seriously affected by the tight raw material supply situation and this is reflected in the higher prices being offered. In a recent development, new government regulations have been introduced that require forest concessionaires and millers to sell at least 5% of their log and sawn timber production to local market.

Report from Malaysia

The Forestry Department of Peninsular Malaysia has announced that, as part of its action plan to ensure the attainment of sustainable forest management, efforts will be directed towards improving harvesting systems through operational studies to achieve higher efficiency and costeffectiveness.

The Department is working towards increasing the value of timber while drastically reducing the impact of logging. It is also expanding its reforestation and plantation programmes to produce higher value timbers and raw materials for specialised as well as small-scale industries.

Increased effort is to be put into reducing the high level of volume losses due to felling breakage, high stumps and short logs that are left in the forest after harvesting. These harvesting losses are estimated to be as high as 30% and 45% of the total utilisable volume.



Sarawak veneer and plywood giant, Jaya Tiasa Holdings Bhd is set to become the largest stock exchange listed timber concessionaire in Malaysia, having proposed to acquire about 750,000 hectares of timber concessions in Sarawak. For this upstream move, Jaya Tiasa is proposing to acquire 12 timber licensee companies.


Some 200 local companies participated in the show and more than 4000 foreign trade visitors visited the Fair. The






From Europe, An Update on Italy

The Italian market was featured in the very first issue of this report. Now, after 2 months, the same industrialists and manufacturers have been contacted to provide an update of prices and trends in the market. It will be seen from the prices below that all of the companies are indicating that they are maintaining the same price lists as two months ago.



The trade is reporting a dull domestic market. Contrary to expectations the European market is showing no signs of recovery as yet. Some manufacturers have indicated that despite the sluggish market a modest price increase may be necessary next month.






In the first two months of the year domestic sales have dropped, after the modest 4% rise in 1995 and this has meant that Italian furniture companies have no opportunity to increase prices to offset rising costs. It is now forecast that in 1996 furniture prices in the domestic and even European market, will increase by no more than a modest 3 - 4%.


The Italian group Arquati, a world leader in the frames sector, has acquired 100% of Mobilac, a furniture manufacturer located in Fornovo near Parma. In 1995 Mobilac, which produces wardrobes and bedroom furniture, achieved a turnover of 18 billion lira with a staff of 50.

With an optimistic eye to the future in its particular market segment, the furniture and furnishings retail chain Habitat will open its first 10 Italian shops before the end of May. Following a joint-venture with the Italian group Rinascente, Habitat (controlled by the Swedish furniture group Ikea) will manage 10 of the 28 outlets of the Croff retail chain. Habitat planned an investment of about 30 billion lira.



The Italian textile group, Stefanel, has started a restructuring policy to streamline the company's activities. The group has started trade discussions with the business bank Schroder in order to sell its stake in kitchen furniture company Veneta Cucine.

Other News from Europe

The German company Schaerf AG. a prominent office furniture manufacturer, has raised its stake in Sitag Sitzmoebel to 100% (up from 51%). Sitag, which is located in Porta Westfalica, has a turnover of DM42 million, while Schaerf registered a turnover of DM282.9 million in the first six months of 1995.

In the UK the office furniture group Calderburn is to sell Cooper Dauphin, producer of wood-veneered office furniture. Senator International (office furniture) has agreed to pay GBpounds5.5 million for Cooper Dauphin's loss-making office furniture division. The purchase will allow Senator to lift its annual sales from GBpounds20 to 30 million.

In Germany the furniture retail group ASKO has reported that sales fell by 8.1% to DM2,134 billion in the year up to September 1995.

In more takeover news, this time in France, the investment fund Ciclad has taken over the majority stake (40%0 of the French manufacturer Gruther from British fund Schroders. In 1995 Gruhier's sales reached Ffr245 million, with a staff of 370.

In Germany, high quality and comparatively low cost PVC foil laminated MDF furniture doors, notably from Italy, are successfully penetrating the market. After showing good growth in recent years the solid wood segment of the furniture and door market appears to be succumbing to competition. A new player in this market is Eastern Europe and some of the bigger consumers in the US are taking advantage of this change in demand


The MDF market is still very price competitive. The demand for thin boards is currently very good and the thinner boards are to some extent replacing HFH boards

US Industry Report

Prices for US primary wood products, including engineered boards, continue the weak pattern shown in the first two months of the year and reflect the pattern apparent throughout 1995. Most prices have declined during the past 12 months. The erosion was most pronounced for engineered boards with the exception of plywood. 
Lumber prices are holding up better than the engineered boards, but are also lower than 12 months ago. The processed products (with a higher value added) declined the least. For example, hardwood dimension stock prices fell by only 1.3%, while rough, unprocessed hardwood lumber fell by 4.4%.

Contrary to the price movements of US domestic wood products, importers are reporting that prices for imported woods continue an upward trend. This is seen as a direct result of the ever scarcer supply of high quality furniture woods, partially brought about by the accelerating moves towards sustainable forestry. Mahogany prices have increased by 8% over the past 12 months.



Plywood and Veneer

Prices for plywood are, currently, firm and have increased moderately in the past 12 months. However, the market is rather erratic, as seen from the recent wide price movements.


As of early March 1996, MDF prices were 12% below prices of a year earlier, and particleboard prices were 7.7% lower. The reason for this decline is to be found in a growing over-capacity for these boards and with relatively low demand, due mainly to the lackluster housing and furniture markets.

Millwork

In the wood mouldings industry prices have declined by 7.8% during the past 12 months. This is due to the slow housing market, the primary consumer of these products. Window and door producers, who also cater to house builders, were somewhat shielded from the market weakness due to a fairly strong demand from the remodeling and renovation trade.

Wooden Furniture

Prices for finished and semifinished wood products increased moderately in the first two months of 1996 which mirror a trend seen last year. The strongest price increases occurred for office desks (4.8%), and dining room tables (4.1%). These products have a relatively high component of exotic woods, and the price rises are partially the result of higher wood prices.

Wood products manufactured from North American as opposed to imported woods also witnessed some price advances. This, coupled with falling raw material prices, suggests that many manufacturers in the secondary wood products industry were able to improve their operating margins.
